LA COUNTY FIREFIGHTERS WELCOME PEER SUPPORT DOGS TO LAUNCH NEW PEER SUPPORT K9 PROGRAM

LA County Firefighters will accept the donation of two fully trained peer support/comfort dogs from leading dog training foundations, Thor's Hope Foundation in partnership with Performance K9 Training, Inc. and the Patriotic Service Dog Foundation as they launch new Peer Support K9 Program for the Los Angeles County Fire Department.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY—On Tuesday, Los Angeles County Firefighters will accept the donation of two fully trained peer support dogs from the nation's leading dog training foundations, the Thor's Hope Foundation in partnership with Performance K9 Training, Inc. and the Patriotic Service Dog Foundation, to launch the new Peer Support K9 Program.

Dogs "Milo" and "Echo" were specially selected and completed hundreds of hours of intense specialized training to support firefighters with PTSD or high levels of anxiety in a variety of situations and settings. They not only assist in identifying individuals experiencing increased levels of stress, they are also trained to comfort those individuals. These two dogs are the first in a new Peer Support K9 Program in the Los Angeles County Fire Department. Both dogs have already been deployed to assist firefighters and first responders on the recent Bobcat Fire, where crews were facing one of the largest wildfires in LA County's history which lasted over one month. *(See attached bios of dogs)*

Over the last five years, the number of suicide for firefighters has surpassed the number of line of duty deaths nationwide. As our firefighters face an unprecedented wildfire season and everincreasing call loads with the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the mental and physical health of our firefighters has never been more critical. The addition of peer support dogs will help first responders manage stress and anxiety during large-scale incidents and extended deployments.

The launch of the Peer Support K9 Program is the latest addition to LA County's robust peer support program which incudes over 130 trained peers. LA County's Peer Support Program is an award-winning innovative program that has been deployed nationwide to assist firefighters and first responders with traumatic large-scale incidents. LA County's Peer Support Team has been deployed to incidents such as the murder of Captain David Rosa in Long Beach, the ambush

shooting of Firefighters in Eugene, Oregon, the Borderline Mass Shooting in Thousand Oaks, the Route 91 Harvest mass shooting in Las Vegas and multiple line of duty death incidents for first responders nationwide.
